## LBHF Schools' Arts Charter How to apply

## Step 1: Complete an expression of interest by 31st Jan 2020

Follow this <u>link</u> to complete an expression of interest. This will ask you to nominate a curriculum lead for arts to attend a <u>Arts 'Good Practice' Network CPD on 4th Feb 2020</u> at at <u>either</u> **2-4pm** or **4-6pm**. The CPD takes place at the Lilla Husset Centre. Book in to a session <u>here</u>.

## Step 2: Arts 'Good Practise' Network CPD: 4th Feb 2020 Lilla Husset Centre.

A nomincated Arts Lead from each school will attend a CPD session to complete a 'Pupil Experience Guarantee' for 2020/21. This will be a faclitated session run by the Learning Partnership and the Lyric Hammersmith Theatre. Download the sample PEG here.

For this session your nominated teacher must bring the following -

- 1) A curriculum overview of your school's arts provision across all phases/key stages
- 2) The names of your school's 'Arts Charter Advocates' as appointed by your Head Teacher:
  - 1 Governor
  - 1 Teacher
  - 1 Pupil
  - 1 Parent

This group will be asked to endorse your 'Pupil Experience Guarantee' (PEG) and sign your school's copy of the LBHF Schools' Arts Charter.

## Step 3: Submit your 'Pupil Experience Guarantee' (PEG) by 24th April 2020.

Each nominated Arts Lead submits their PEG by 24<sup>th</sup> April 2020. This is then reviewed and, if approved, your school's logo will appear on the digital Schools' Arts Charter and a hardcopy will be sent by end of June 2020.

Sign 4: Sign and display the LBHF Schools' Arts Charter and your school's PEG.

Step 5: Attend the Lyric Education conference (July 2020) (optional)
