SUBMISSIONS

H&F Writers' Festival will only consider submissions from the Poetry and short stories genres. Whether it's controversial or explicit, childish or colourful, our panel of readers and judges will undertake a comprehensive review.

What to send

All you need to do is send across the full manuscript of your poem or short story clearly marked with your name, age and the title of submission at the top of each page.

- Submissions must be written in English and be no more than 3000 words.
- Submissions must be typed, double-spaced, on single-sided sheets and in a readable, 12 point font and each page numbered.
- Three poems and one story per person
- The Competition is open to different age ranges and will be clearly presented on competition materials and competition web pages.
- Categories for entry are listed:

Children's Category: 5-7 years old, 8-11 years old and 12-15 years old

Young Adults Category: 16-18 years old

Adult Category: 18+ years old

Please always try to submit a digital copy of your work, preferably as one single document in Microsoft Word or PDF format.

The H&F Short Story & Poetry Competition 2022 is now open for entries inspired by the theme: 'I Can and I Will'.

Please read these competition rules. By entering our competition we will assume that you have read these rules and that you agree to them.

The Competition opens on 31st January 2022 and closes 18th June 2022. Please note all submissions must be received by midnight on 18th June 2022 cannot be accepted after this time.

TERMS OF ENTRY

- Entry to the H&F Writers' Festival competition is **FREE** and open to anyone.
- Work must be original (not copied).
- Copyright remains with the author. We cannot publish work without permission.
- Entries must be sent online to **handwritersfestival@outlook.com**
- Each piece of work entered into the Competition must be marked with the entrant's name and age and the title of the story must appear at the top of each page. (Where multiple pieces of work are submitted by a teacher, each individual piece of work must also be marked with the school name and address.)
- Submissions must be written in English and be no more than 3000 words.
- Submissions must be typed, double-spaced, on single-sided sheets and in a readable, 12 point font and each page numbered.
- The title of submission must appear at the top of each page.
- Three poems and one story per person
- The Competition is open to different age ranges and will be clearly presented on competition materials and competition web pages.
- Categories for entry are listed: (Children's) 5-7 years old, 8-11 years old, 12-15 years old, (Young Adult's) 16-18 years old and (Adults) 18+ years old. Poems or Short Stories only.
- Competition closes midnight **18th June 2022** and are clearly marked on any competition materials and competition web pages. You can view opening/closing dates for past and current competitions on our website.
- A panel of readers and judges will consider all entries anonymously.
- The members of the organising committee and the panel of readers are not eligible to enter the competition.

- Prizes: First, Runner-Up and Second Prize
- Results will be announced at the Awards Presentation Evening on 21st August 2022.
- H&F Writers' Festival main competitions may be subject to change
- H&F Writers' Festival reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition the rules and the terms and conditions of entry at any time and without prior notice.
