## Supporting Parents/Caregivers on the Toilet Training Journey



“Toilet Training” implies that as Parents/Caregivers they have to teach their children – and that the success or failure falls on them.

“Toilet Learning” acknowledges the child’s part in the process and also takes into account that it usually occurs over time, not all at once.
