Please check your child is up to date with their immunisations including MMR

There have been recent cases of **measles** in London, so it's important to make sure your child is up to date with all their routine vaccinations, to protect them from infectious diseases.

Your children's **12-month vaccinations** and "**pre-school booster**" (given between 3 years 4 months, and 5 years - can be given later if you've missed it) are the best way to protect your child from measles and other infectious diseases.
