Composer Sally Hebert has performed across multiple genres working with international artists (Radiohead, Kylie Minogue, Mumford & Sons, Ellie Goulding, Manic Street Preachers) and with the likes of the Royal Philharmonic and London Symphony orchestras. Sally brings to the English Chamber Orchestra a brilliant musical score that bridges the boundaries between film music and the concert stage.

Oswald is a musician and puppet master who breathes life into the puppet animals at the City Theatre. When all the puppet animals escape the future of the famous theatre is at stake until the young Isabelle, daughter of the theatre's ice cream seller, summons the courage to master the power of the Gazillium Music machine to make beautiful music and restore order.

Alongside Sally Herbert's original composition, there will also be a performance of a School's composition, Amelia and the Robot, and Copland's Appalachian Spring Suite (original version).
