Following training, you will be able to:

- \checkmark Understand that autism is a difference rather than a deficit or disorder.
- Recognise the Three Areas of Difference in autism and how these can impact on a child's levels of anxiety.
- Recognise the first step to helping a child is to learn about them, their triggers and their preferred means of support.
- Reflect on practice and implement reasonable adjustments to reduce anxiety in autistic children.
